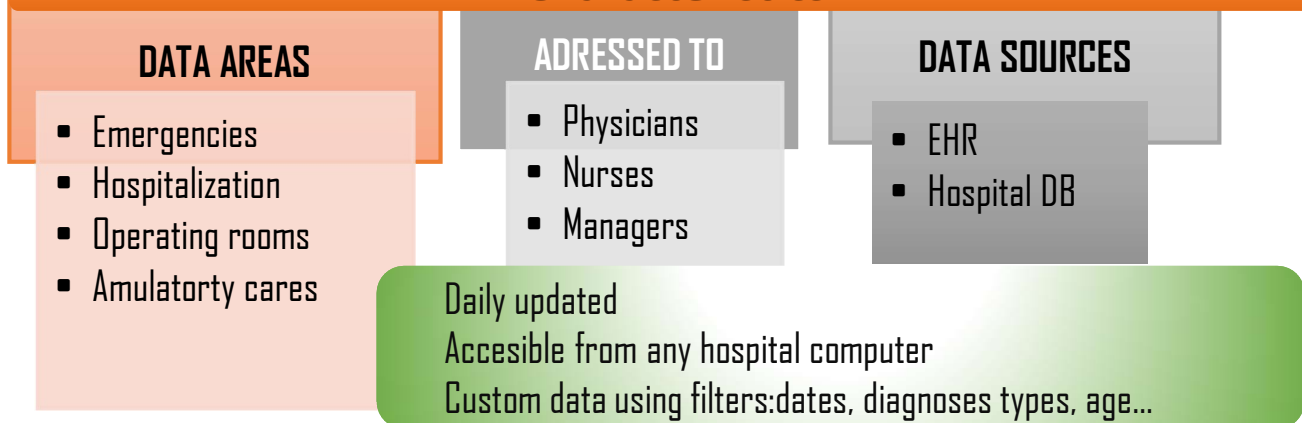
Health Data has experienced an explosion with the EHR and other information-gathering databases. We need **accurate, complete, and reliable data, organized and related in a way let make the best decisions.**

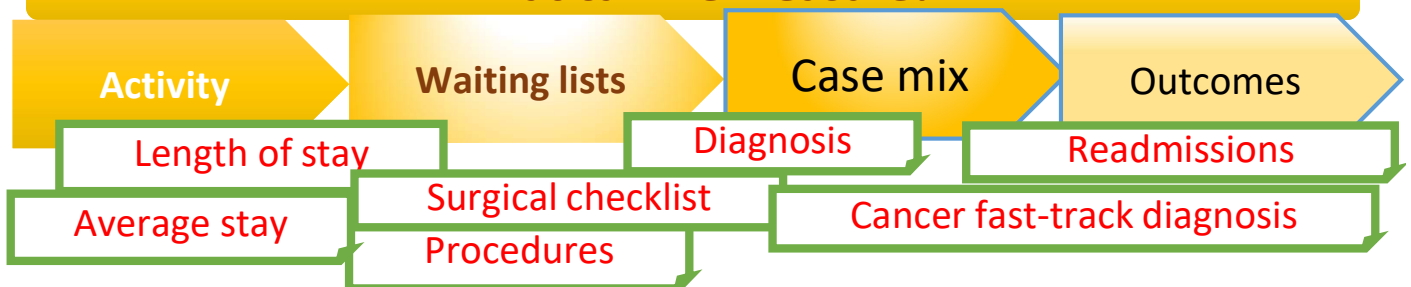
We describe the design and implementation of an **electronic dashboard** developed between **Health Informatics and Health Information Management (HIM)**
